

## How to reinstall the *Traveller* client on a workstation

- Ensure the workstation is connected to the network and can see the Traveller server. Also ensure that you are logged in as the Administrator.
- On the workstation, click **Start, Run** and type [\\servername\sharename\conctrav\setupws.exe](#) which will open up the Traveller client install. (NB: Where 'servername' and 'sharename' are you will need to put in the actual servername and share name.)
- This will start the installation process. Accept all default options by just clicking the '**Next**' button, and Traveller should re-install fairly promptly.
- Open Traveller using the icon on the desktop. If this is the first time you have run Traveller, you may be asked to install some extra software (*Run Time Libraries*). Same as before, accept all default options by clicking the '**Next**' button until its finished. A request to restart the computer may appear too, you can say **no** to this, as it is not required.
- When you get the Traveller sign-in box, sign in as usual. Select **Tools/Options** and **Printer Allocation**. Select the correct printer for each Traveller document type.
- You are done! You can now work in Traveller as normal, however, remember to log back into Windows as the user, rather than staying in as the administrator.
